- 2.2 If you contact us, we may keep a record of that correspondence;
- 2.3 We may also ask you to complete surveys that we use for research purposes, although you do not have to respond to them;
- 2.4 Details of any transactions you carry out through our site
- 2.5 Details of your visits to our site including, but not limited to, traffic data, location data, weblogs and other communication data and the resources that you access; and
- 2.6 Any information incidental to that listed above.
- 2.7 We also collect Biometric data (heart rates or brainwaves). This information is only displayed as first names only of each individual or as an aggregate team score. We would ask for a further opt in signed by individuals or teams for the purposes of joint promotional activities that required identifying team members.
- 2.9 All data collected via Newsletter sign up forms via MailerLite will be GDPR compliant and allow unsubscribe functions.
- 2.10 Data collected via our bluetooth marketing will not collect personal data and only send information upon public request (data captured will be mobile device name only).

## 3. Information we process about End Users
